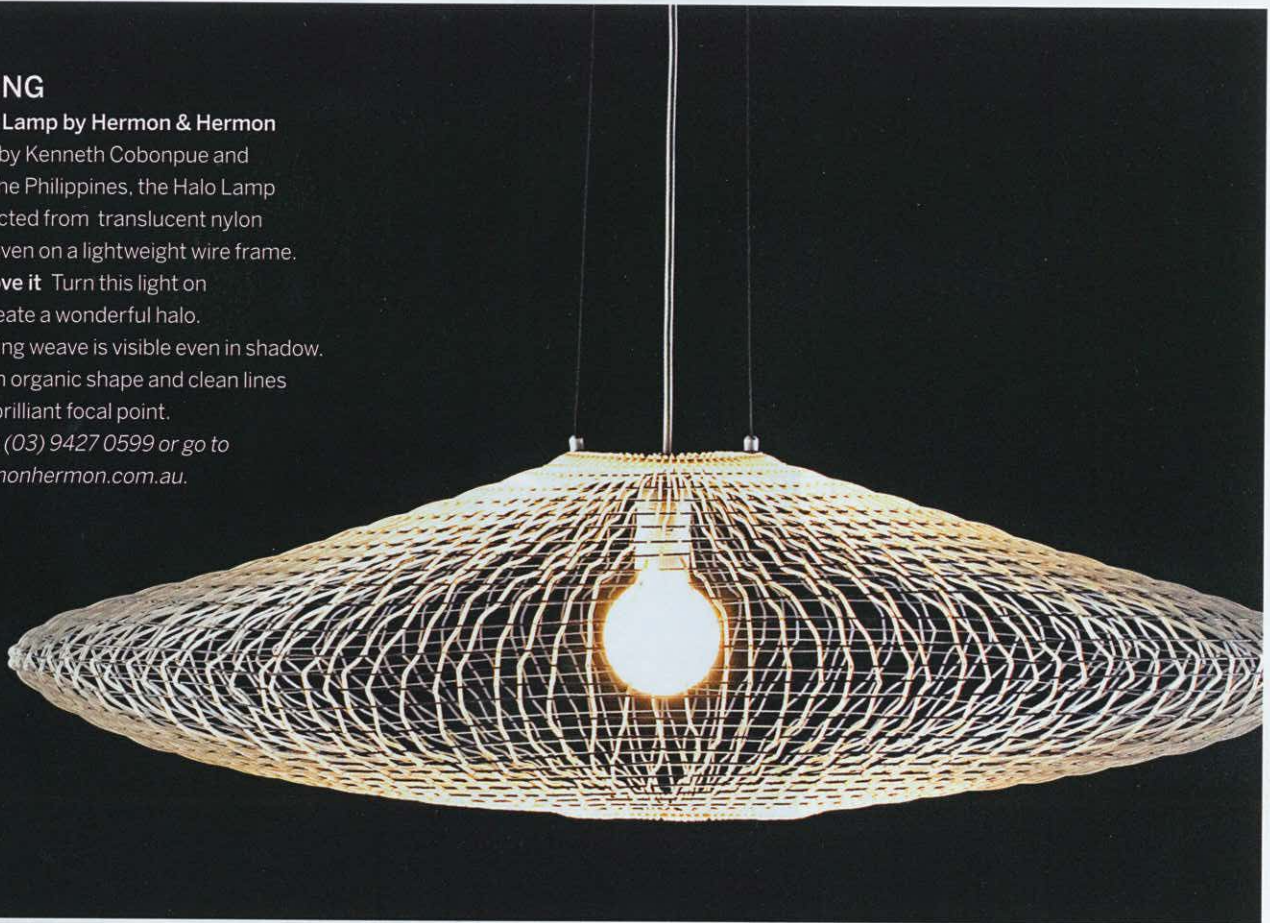
**Halo Disc Lamp by Hermon & Hermon**
