"The Salvador Dali cookbook is one of John's favourites. It's a collector's classic, full of wild and over-the-top recipes. The Bulul figure – the rice God of the Ifagao tribe from the northern Philippines – watches over us and guards the entry to our home. It provides an impressive way to welcome visitors."
